3 IN 1 SOLAR KIT



EAR SPY

The Ear Spy allows you to hear every whispered conversation in the room. It intensifies sound and transfers it to your nearly invisible earphone. The ear mounted sound amplifier device is portable and fits easily over the left ear. Its tiny microphone can pick up conversations up to 80 feet away and relays this to an earphone in your right ear. An amplifier built into the device increases the level of ambient sound in a room. Due to feedback the earphone must never be used in the same ear as the listening device.

GAGA CAMERA GLASSES

Lifecasting devices are interesting—you wear them as they unobtrusively capture photos, video, sound (or all three) as you make sandwiches or walk the dog. Although “unobtrusive” really isn’t the idea behind Polaroid’s GL20 Gaga-designed camera glasses, which take and display interval-shot photos taken with a lens on the bridge.
